A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to make certain spouses eligible for services under the disabled veterans' outreach program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Gold Star and Sur-
5 viving Spouse Career Services Act".

1 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF SPOUSES FOR SERVICES UNDER**
2 **THE DISABLED VETERANS' OUTREACH PRO-**
3 **GRAM.**

4 Section 4103A of title 38, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)—

7 (A) in paragraph (1)—

8 (i) in the matter preceding subpara-
9 graph (A), by inserting “and eligible per-
10 sons” after “eligible veterans”; and

11 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
12 “, and eligible persons,” after “Other eligi-
13 ble veterans”;

14 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “and el-
15 igible persons” after “veterans” each place it
16 appears; and

17 (C) in paragraph (3)—

18 (i) by inserting “or eligible person”
19 after “veteran” each place it appears; and

20 (ii) by inserting “or eligible person’s”
21 after “veteran’s”;

22 (2) in subsection (d)(1)—

23 (A) by inserting “and eligible persons”
24 after “eligible veterans” each place it appears;
25 and

26 (B) by striking “non-veteran-related”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 section:

3 “(e) **ELIGIBLE PERSON DEFINED.**—In this section,
4 the term ‘eligible person’ means—

5 “(1) any spouse described in section 4101(5) of
6 this title; or

7 “(2) the spouse of any person who died while
8 a member of the Armed Forces.”.
